

Jolly Olly's Coffee Shop, established in 2011, is situated in the centre of the village opposite the village schools. Probably the most important member of our team is Jolly Olly himself. Our resident Coffee Bean and his wife Lola Granola live in the shop with their two children Bean and Has Bean and keep an eye on us all, making sure we are providing a service he can be proud of and a jolly atmosphere to reflect our jolly name!

Our mission is to offer a good range of well presented, tasty food that provides value for money, in an environment where excellent customer service is always given and where we play a positive role within the community.

Our menu choices include; homemade cakes, sandwiches and toasties, prepared to order, and freshly ground coffee. We support our Village Butcher, selling his tasty homemade sausages and freshly cut ham. Vegetarian, gluten free and dairy free options are also available and we offer outside catering for small functions.

The community which we serve is wide ranging and we try to be aware of the differing needs and desires of our customers. For our youngest visitors we have a play table, high chairs, baby changing facilities and a kids' menu. We have free wi-fi for folk wishing to drink coffee as they work (or play!) There is also an outside seating area with doggie bowls and a doggie parking area for our waggly friends.

We try to facilitate a community spirit from within the shop, aiming to create a friendly atmosphere where everyone is welcome. We organise various events through which folk can get to know their neighbours and make new friends including a Quiz Night and Jigsaw Puzzle Race Night. We hold a weekly knitting workshop and provide a meeting venue for the local cycling group. We also have a wide selection of second hand books and jigsaws for our customers to swap or by.

We are keen to support the local Parish Council and Oakley Community Association by, for example, selling the local Link Magazine and tickets for local events such as the annual Firework display. We have a community board and stand in the shop and sell goods on behalf of local people with the vast majority of the proceeds being given to charity.
